Native Range: South Florida north to Brevard County

Description: Evergreen tree to 30 feet

Flowering Season: Spring Flowers, Edible berries in the Fall

**Exposure: Full Sun to light shade
Moderately Salt Tolerant**

Moisture: Moist to average

USDA Hardiness Zone: 10-11
