Family: Rutaceae

Native Range: Central to South Florida, Texas to Tropical America

Description: Dioecious evergreen woody shrub to 16 ft.

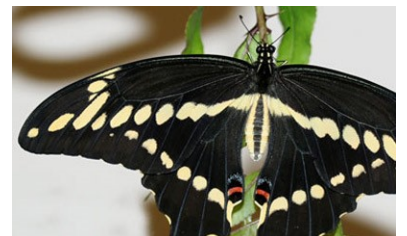
Flowering season: Inconspicuous flowers and small fruit for birds in fall

Exposure: Full sun to partial shade



Moisture: Average to dry
Salt Tolerant

USDA Hardiness Zone: 9-11
