Rhus copallinum



Family: Anacardiaceae

Native Range: Southeastern U.S to South Florida

Description: Fall color; Deciduous shrub to 15 ft.

Flowering Season: Spring, Make tea with fruit

Exposure: Full sun to partial shade

Moisture: Average to dry

Not Salt Tolerant

USDA Hardiness Zone: 8-10

Attracts butterflies, native bees and other pollinators; Food source for migratory birds
